# My Newman Center Experience: A reflection on the welcoming community at the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center

My name is Heriberto Vasquez, also known as Beto. I am a 4th year Mechanical Engineering student at Fresno State. I grew up in a little town about an hour south of Fresno called Lindsay. Growing up in a very Catholic family, I was at our local parish almost every day of the week attending the ministries my parents were involved in, the catechism classes that my parents taught and worship nights on Friday evenings. From the moment I was born until I moved to Fresno for school, this parish was my "home" and yet many times it did not feel this way. It wasn't until I made my way to the Newman Center that I would come to know and understand what that really means.

I was originally drawn in by the curiosity of Bible study held on Monday nights. But what I found however, was far more than a young adult Bible study group. What I found was a place where I feel comfortable to share and grow my faith with other young people. Since joining I've been involved in many things such as helping plan a student retreat, going to World Youth Day, and even being hired to work at the front desk. Even more recently I had the opportunity to walk with one of my best friends during his confirmation journey and had the honor of being his sponsor. All this would not be possible without the support and participation of the entire community, so a very heartfelt thank you to everyone for making the Newman Center the place that it is.




