My Covenant With You

Today in Genesis, God established a covenant with us after the great flood to never again devastate the world with a flood. Through Salvation History, we also see covenants with Abraham, with the captives of Egypt, and with King David. With each covenant, God is promising good for His people, but increasingly is asking for His people to be faithful by the way they live their lives.

Today, In Psalm 25, we hear a request in the covenant agreement with God, "Your ways, O Lord, are love and truth to those who keep your covenant."

The Psalm is reinforcing a responsibility on our side to keep the covenant by being faithful through our lives. We heard this same message on Ash Wednesday as we received ashes to mark the beginning of our Lenten Journey:

"Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel." So our challenge now is to examine our lives and to see how best we can fulfill our side of the agreement to live faithfully to God's will for us.

We experience a beautiful story and example in the Gospels as a way to examine our lives during Lent. We witness Jesus starting his holy journey with 40 days in the desert. However, Jesus did not just walk into the desert, in fact we hear that "the Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert "! That sounds so wonderful and scary at the same time. Am I willing to ask the Holy Spirit to "drive" me into a desert, or am I more comfortable just walking around the perimeter?

I hope you join me during Lent to seek out intentional opportunities to join Jesus in the desert. Here are a few ideas:

Fasting: Turn off all electronics and find a quiet place to walk or sit. No prayers needed, just provide an opportunity for God to speak and for you to hear.

Almsgiving: Give some time for your Faith Community; meet others after Mass in the cafeteria, join parishioners at the Fish Fry, set up family prayer time.

Prayer: Add an extra prayer activity: Friday Stations of the Cross, Adoration, find an online prayer source or prayer app, use the Daily Reflection booklet.

We are a wonderful parish community called to worship, pray, and serve God! May we all be blessed with fruitful time in the desert with Jesus.






