# THE DEACON'S SPEAKIN'

Dear sisters and brothers,

One quote from Jesus in today's gospel prompted me to return to a "Deacon's Speakin" that I wrote three years ago. "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold."

I often meet with or hear of persons who cause me to wonder, "Are they not the members of the 'other sheep' that Jesus spoke of in today's Gospel". I recently met an elderly gentleman who had been away from the church for 40 years. He was diagnosed with a terminal illness and expressed with confidence that he was going to a good place. He may not be claimed by a church or a creed, but he seemed to know who his shepherd was.

The Church, like any institution, has its way of defining outsiders and insiders. Baptism is that dividing line of "welcome" and heresy is at the far end of "goodbye". But, even the early church recognized that Gentiles could receive the Holy Spirit without baptism and, in our present community, we know some who are baptized and confirmed and show no sign of grace operating inside of them. Once theologians taught a theology of Limbo – a place that would catch those souls who, through no fault of their own, went unbaptized.


But Jesus claimed a separate flock as His own from the very beginning of His ministry. He didn't stop to make rules about who they might be – committed Buddhists? – Faithful Mormons? – divorced and remarried Catholics – members of the LGBTQ community – and flat-out atheists who have never found a faith community to call home or a sense of peace in organized religion. Jesus knows who His people are and they know Him. We might want to be cautious about closing the door to salvation on anyone!

# FATHER NEGRO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE!

Applications for Sergio P Negro Scholarships for the 2024-25 academic year are now available on the St. Paul Catholic



Newman Center web site. The Sergio P Negro Endowment Fund was established in honor of our founding priest, Sergio Negro, who had a deep and abiding commitment to education. The Endowment Fund antici-

pates awarding a minimum of two, \$2,500 scholarships to deserving students for the academic year. Past awardees are eligible to reapply as long as they have maintained satisfactory progress.

To be eligible, you must be either an upper division undergraduate or a graduate student preparing to use your knowledge and skills to witness and minister to others. This is meant to inclusive of many vocations and forms of service, including education, medicine, social services, etc. A precondition is that you must have either been raised within or are currently affiliated and active with our St. Paul Catholic Newman Center parish beyond attending mass. An overall GPA of 2.5 or greater is also required.

The deadline for applications to be received is 5:00 pm on Sunday, April 21, 2024.
