THE DEACON'S SPEAKIN'

Dear sisters and brothers,

Chances are you're reading this wearing glasses or contact lenses. And when you sit down to read, you may have noticed that worrisome stab of pain in your left knee. A growing waistline may also be a concern for you. Lately, too, you may find that when you feel a sneeze coming on, you straighten yourself quickly and line up all your body parts so that the force of the "ah-choo" doesn't knock anything out of kilter. "Salud!" That's our bodies. Like old cars, years and miles take their toll. It's part and parcel to living in an inherently flawed body.

How astonishing; then, that God would condescend to take human form and enter a flawed body like ours. "Not my body", you might say. And you'd be wrong – precisely your body. "You are Christ's body", Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 12:27. God has chosen us to be the dwelling place and sign of the divine presence in the world. With all our imperfections and sinfulness, God freely and gladly makes a home in us. "This is my body" Jesus says today and offers bread and wine. Eating and drinking, we are united with Christ. His flesh becomes our flesh. His blood flows in our veins. We become one with God and God becomes one with us.

Knowing this, we can no longer look on our bodies in terms of sin and imperfection. We're sinners – that's true. We experience that disturbing fact every day of our journey. We confess our sins, thinking that maybe somehow that grace will make them go away. But it only reminds us that we are forgiven and that God is content to embrace our human weakness and live in our mortal bodies despite our sins.



Men's Ministry


Men's Weekly Scripture Reflection and Discussion Group: This ministry meets on Monday mornings at 8:30am in the Library after 8:00am morning Mass.


Prayer Ministry
