If I had faith like a mustard seed, how would I live my life authentically?

As a twenty-four year old writing this weekend's bulletin letter, I find myself struggling with faith... every single day. Although, in today's readings, Jesus is talking to me and you. He is telling you and me not to worry, not to think ahead, but to look at every day as a tiny seed that will eventually become fruitful and wondrous. For me, a mustard seed symbolizes the gentle touch from Jesus through healing and stillness. Sometimes in a noisy and broken world, we lose or stay far from the seed of courage, the seed of hope, and the seed of perseverance.

Some of us, including myself, may have grown up in a weeded plant and with an absent father waiting for that seed to grow. However, I want you to take a moment and reflect on the quiet times where Jesus watered the seed inside of you. No one can take the seed from you, so you must continue to water your own seed and God will do the rest.

If you are on the top of the highest mountain or at the lowest, He will meet you there because He is your Father "And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come." God said be a mustard seed, and in the midst of the unknown, perhaps you and I will walk by faith and not by sight. We will be on this journey together.


