The young adult team and I would like to invite you to our day retreat, next Saturday from 10am - 5pm right here at the Newman Center.


It is so important in our busy lives to make time for community. This is a great opportunity to meet fellow Catholics and share your experiences. No matter where we are on our journeys, we all walk together.

It will be a prayerful and uplifting day--and fun too!




RCIA
