JOIN US FOR FAITH, FAMILY, & FRIENDS!

I am happy to announce that Faith Family & Friends, our Newman Center's Religious Education and Faith Formation program for EVERYONE begins Tuesday evening, September 19th at 6:00 – 7:00pm in Cardinal Newman Hall! Faith Family & Friends is not just for families with children, but is an opportunity for everyone to become life-long learners of their faith. It provides participants the opportunity to form friendship bonds and offers a place where we can question and discuss important elements of our Catholic Christian faith together. Besides religious education and sacrament preparation for children and youth, Faith, Family & Friends, provides options for adults. Adult sessions include topics on Catholic Faith, Spirituality, Scripture, Prayer, Holistic Health, Parenting and Relationships.

On opening night, adults will receive an overview of their three learning options and our intergenerational programs. Children and youth will go to their individual classrooms to meet their teachers and classmates, and discover what they will learn throughout the year.

On subsequent Tuesday evenings, families and individuals are invited to meet in Cardinal Newman Hall to share a meal together prior to classes from 5:00- 5:45 pm. At 5:45pm, all FF&F participants are asked to gather in the Cardinal Newman Hall for an opening song, prayer, and welcoming message before dispersing to individual class sessions that begin at 6:00pm.

Adult options for 2023 include: The *Synod on Synodality*, offered by Deacon John and Jim Grant; *Eucharistic Revival Topics on Jesus in the Eucharist* with Ryan & Jessica Borunda; *The Quest for Happiness* with myself; and *SoulCore*, a unique way to pray the Rosary that intentionally engages the whole person by incorporating gentle core strengthening, stretching and functional movements to nourish body, mind & soul and encourage deeper reflection on the mysteries of the rosary and the life of Christ.

As you can see, FF&F offers unique ways for our parish faith family to grow both as a community of believers and in our individual spiritual lives. As followers of Christ Jesus, we gather together to learn from each other how Christ has touched us and to share our individual experiences of God's presence in our lives.

People need a faith community to flourish. People are hungry for a place where they belong, feel connected, share faith and traditions with others, and will be missed if they don't show up. FF&F provides a ready-made, supportive faith-family that our parishioners can access outside of Mass to deepen relationships. People hunger and thirst for this type of social and spiritual encounter. It helps people get through whatever challenges that they may have to endure or confront between meetings. The gathered community of believers is of great significance in our spiritual journey of faith.


