SYNOD: Walking Together, Listening To Each Other

The Synod in Rome just released a two page letter to "The People of God" to **call us** to be a part of the Church discussion as she moves forward in service to God. From the letter:

"She (The Church) needs to welcome the voice of those who want to be involved in lay ministries and to participate in discernment and decisionmaking structures."

This is very powerful as we are being invited to be heard and to participate! Our parish has invited parishioners to be a part of synod listening sessions over the past year, and we are right where we need to be to answer the desire of the Church: **to be involved**.

Based on our listening session feedback, we want to move forward with a **Parish Discernment** during Advent to reflect on "What God Wants From Us" as individuals, as parish members, and as a parish. From that time of prayer and discernment, we will be ready in the New Year to move forward with forming parish "decision-making structures" that allow for your voices to be heard.

This Thursday, we will invite parishioners to plan and work on that Advent Parish Discernment to start the work of empowering our parish to join the journey and spirit of the synod within our parish.

The letter also states:

"The Church also needs to listen to the laity, women and men, all called to holiness by virtue of their baptismal vocation".

I see this as a call for us to join in community and communion with all of our parishioners. I was so blessed to attend the World Youth Day (WYD) sharing on Saturday night. I felt the Holy Spirit in the room as young people shared about their spiritual and physical journey to WYD that has lit a fire inside of them!

I heard: "I am called", "I feel different", and "I felt at home with my faith there" in their messages. These are our parish members, so please take time to seek them out and listen. Their message is a full of hope and spirit which we can all use as we journey in faith together.

Let's continue to welcome and praise, so all feel "at home with (their) faith" in our parish! If we can start there, God will do the rest!


