#### LOVE and VOTE as you will

Growing up in a Catholic family, my parents made sure I attended Mass every day from a young age. After Mass each day, I would go to the library with my friends to read the news. We would look for two things in the newspaper: first, anything about cricket—my favorite game, which I used to be good at (not anymore); and second, any news about America. There was always some news about America, and we would talk about it during our free time at school.

I remember one of my neighbors named his first son after President Nixon and his second son after President Clinton. When I was in the seminary in India, I met a Claretian seminarian who was named after President Bush. Three years ago, he was ordained as a priest.

As I grew up, what caught my attention about the United States was its vibrant democracy. However, we cannot ignore the polarization that is dividing our society, Church, families, and friends. I understand that we hold diverse opinions on political topics. But we, as Catholics, cannot forget an essential teaching: "common ground." I'm sure you would agree that if people with different political viewpoints sit down and talk, they will find more points of agreement than disagreement. We don't need to look for common ground and unity elsewhere; we can find them in the Eucharist.

If you would like to pray for our country on election day, please come. Our church will be open throughout the day, with adoration scheduled at specific times.

As we prepare to vote—and perhaps some of you have already voted—I'd like to remind us that no political body on earth fully represents the teachings of the Catholic Church. For this reason, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops published 'Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship', a teaching document on the political responsibility of Catholics. The document says that "the responsibility to make choices in political life rests with each individual in light of a properly formed conscience." It calls Conscience as "The voice of God resounding in the human heart, revealing the truth to us and calling us to do what is good."


Friends in Christ, please listen to your Conscience. Then, do as Saint Augustine said, "Love and do what you will."

#### All Saint's Day Celebration




