Happy New Year!!

No, I'm not talking about 2024. I'm talking about our new liturgical year. Advent marks the new year in our Church reading cycle. We move from year A into year B. I challenge our community to treat this transition into our new liturgical year differently. Advent is about longing, hope, and new beginnings. I want to take a few sentences and focus on new beginnings.

It is appropriate that we begin our new year with the season of Advent. We take this time to prepare ourselves for the coming of "the word made flesh" - Jesus. It is beginning anew in a different way, by doing something different than we've done before. So how will you approach Advent, and the Christmas season, in a new way?


