

The Newman Center has been the foundation of my faith, family and friends for 48 years. My life has been enriched by those I've had the privilege to serve and serve with.

I have been blessed to have provided support ministries for the divorced and separated, those grieving the loss of loved ones, LGBTQ individuals and their families. I've prepared engaged couples for marriage, provided marriage enrichment classes, retreats and counseling, parenting education and support. I am proud to have brought to the Diocese a new and innovative way of providing religious education through our whole-community, family-centered program, *Faith, Family & Friends*. I've enjoyed holding book studies, teaching scripture and religious education classes, and forward-looking courses like, *Re-imaging God in the New Millennium, The Universal Christ, and Awakening the Hero Within*.

I've worked with many gifted and faith-filled people to develop transformational courses like, *Spirituality of the 12 Steps* and *Come Follow Me* that combine Ignatian Spirituality with the 12-Steps. Many others have helped to develop a variety of ministries like our Holistic Health Ministry that included Tai Chi for Health, Gentle Yoga, and now Soul Core and Faith Community Nursing. We developed a Prayer Ministry that includes Christian Meditation, Rosary groups and Prayer and Life Workshops. I have enjoyed assisting our Campus Ministry by teaching faculty, staff and students on the CSUF campus and on Wednesday evenings. I have been privileged to be a presenter at our Diocesan Religious Education Congress and an active member of the Interfaith Alliance - so many wonderful experiences.



Faith, Family & Friends wishes all of our parishioners a wonderful Christmas and New Year! We will be taking a 3 week break over the holidays but will return on Tuesday, Jan. 9th. We will begin the New Year with a slightly **new schedule:** we will all gather - parents, youth and children - at 6:00pm in Cardinal Newman Hall. Individual class sessions will begin at 6:15pm and end at 7:15pm. This will allow families additional time after work and school activities to arrive with less stress.

Adult Topics: In January, the adults will again have 3 class options: a Family Life topic - Parenting Strategies; a Catholic Faith topic - Caring for the Whole Person & Catholic Apologetics; and a Prayer option - SoulCore.
