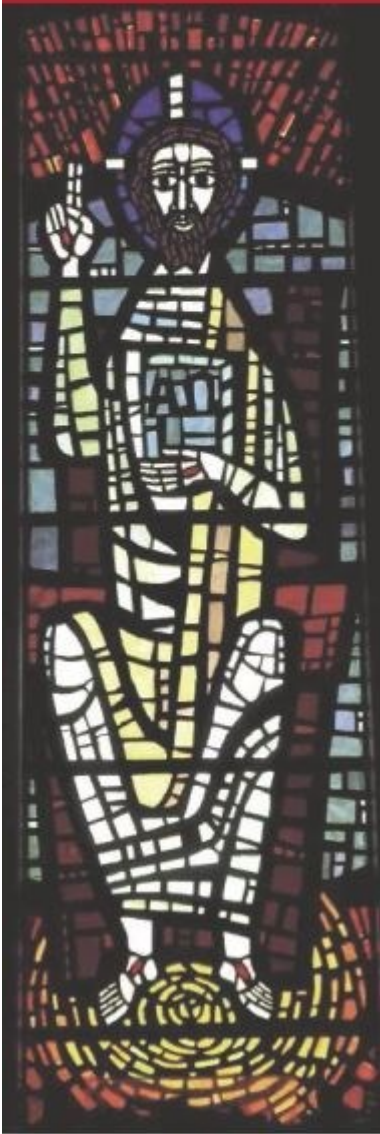

## Third Sunday of Easter

April 10, 2016

**Readings:** Acts 5:27-32,40-41; Rev 5:11-14; Jn 21:1-19

*The Deacon's Speakin'*

***Eucharist is God's gift asking for a response.***

*Each time we share in the Eucharist banquet we are invited to be aware of God's gracious gifts to us. The gift of Eucharist is already a share in Jesus' risen life. By eating and drinking the precious Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, we are transformed into being more perfect members of the Body of Christ. This means that we are to follow Jesus more perfectly since we are more identified with Him. We are called to follow Him even to places "where you do not want to go (Jn 21:18). Therefore, the gift of Eucharist requires us to respond in kind! **Jesus' gift of Himself to us means that we respond with the gift of ourselves to others.***

*This is far from a private act. Eucharist is the action of the whole church through which we share in God's abundant Life and are called to being that Life to others. Essential to Eucharist is a call to love and doing what is morally right on behalf of the whole world. One way to evaluate the quality of our eucharistic celebrations is not by focusing on the elements of the liturgical rite itself (as important as that is), but by focusing on how Jesus' life is lived in the community – not any community, but in this community in which we live!!*

***If we don't become more loving, more charitable, and more just because of Jesus' self-gift of His Body and Blood, then clearly those celebrations – those liturgies – are not doing what they're supposed to do!***

*We must ask ourselves: Are we going to spread the Good News as Peter and the apostles did in Jerusalem and are we going to "obey God rather than men"? (Acts 5:30) How do we visibly love one another more? How are we making a difference in our neighborhoods, city, nation, world? Do we commit to the general intercessions (Prayer of the Faithful) that go beyond the celebration of the Eucharist and demand a commitment of life from us? What places is Jesus asking us to go that are not where we want to go?*
