Readings: **Ecc 1:2; 2:21-23; Col 3:1-5,9-11; Lk 12:13-21**

In his recent apostolic exhortation to families, *The Joy of Love*, Pope Francis states, “*Dear Mothers: thank you! Thank you for what you are in your family and for what you give to the Church and to the world!*” In line with the Pope’s praise and encouragement for mothers, St. Paul Catholic Newman Center is starting a Moms Group as part of our Family Life Ministry. 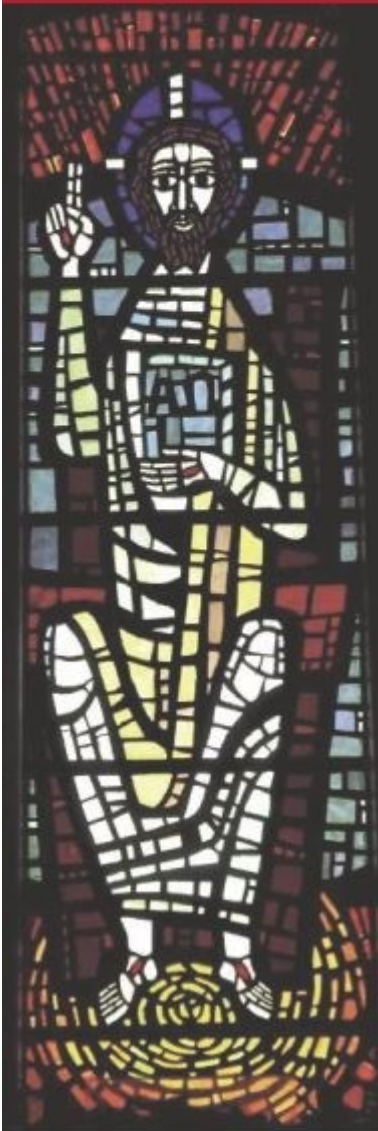
